NEW NON EMERGENCY NUMBER - Police forces in the South East have introduced a new **101** non-emergency telephone number, providing a new way for the public contact them with concerns that **DO NOT** need an urgent response. The benefits of **101**:



- will help communities keep their neighbourhoods safe by offering one easy way to reach their local police and report non-emergency crime and disorder
- make the police more accessible, whilst reducing pressure on the 999 system and helping the police allocate resources where they are most needed
- assist the police to cut crime by making it easier for the public to pass on information about issues in their neighbourhoods.

NEW HIGHWAY STEWARD - Dan Leslie took on his new role on Monday 14th November and will be responsible for Horam. His main duties include:

- Highway safety inspections
- Street Inspections to ensure works are being carried out in the public highway safely and to required specifications
- Building trusted and lasting relationships within the local community
